The 65th Annual Los Angeles County Science & Engineering Fair is scheduled for **March 26-28**, 2015 at the **Pasadena Convention Center**. The Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE) is pleased to partner with the Los Angeles County Science & Engineering Fair organization on this annual event. *The Science Fair website at <u>www.lascifair.org</u> provides access to all essential resources needed by Site Coordinators and participants.* Each participating school may submit thirteen projects; three of which may be a "team project" of 2-3 students.

Important Information:

- (1) Registration Fee: A registration fee of \$200.00 will be assessed per school. (Home-schooled students, \$25.00 per entry.) A 20% discount is given if registration is received by December 5, 2014. Registration Fee Application is available for download from the website and must accompany payment.
- (2) Onsite Registration and Project Setup: Student onsite registration and project setup is scheduled for Thursday, March 26, 2015. All projects must be set up at the Pasadena Convention Center on this date; otherwise, the projects will <u>not be accepted</u> for entrance into the Science Fair
- (3) Judging: All judging will be done on <u>one day</u> (Friday, March 27th). <u>All</u> students, not just finalists, must return on Friday to be interviewed between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. (More detailed information to follow.)

School Online Registration must be completed by **Friday**, **January 30**, **2015**. Printed instructions for the Site Science Fair Coordinator, Student Online Registration and Volunteer Online Registration will be available on the website.

Science Fair Site Coordinator Workshops, for new, as well as experienced Site Coordinators, are scheduled in September and October 2014. *An electronic flyer with workshop information is available for download from the website*. *Please note: A science project display should include a board, a thorough Research Plan and a Daily Log*.

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All students are required to register **online** for the Science Fair. Online registration procedures are included in the Science Fair packet emailed to each Science Fair Site Coordinator in January 2015. The student online registration will be open for two months prior to the Science Fair. **No late registrations will be accepted under any circumstances**.

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<u>Important Reminder</u>: Any student who plans a project involving tissues/cell lines, human subjects, vertebrate animals, hazardous materials or microbes <u>must receive pre-approval</u> by the Los Angeles County Science Review Committee (SRC) <u>prior</u> to beginning research on any project destined for the Los Angeles County Science Fair.

<u>NEW:</u> Site Coordinators must access an ONLINE Pre-Approval Certification site for submitting information contained on Certification Form 601-068 for Junior Division, and the ISEF Form for Senior Division on the Science Fair website at <u>www.lascifair.org</u>. Directions for submission and approval will be available online in early September, 2014.

The Los County Science & Engineering Fair will no longer accept mailed, PDF email or faxed hard copies of Certification Forms - no exceptions.
